

THE LIFE STORY OF —

Ellen C. Erickson, 89

Ellen Caroline Erickson, daughter of Erick and Anna Lee Erickson, was born May 7, 1893 on the family farm in Lincoln twp., Shelby co. She attended Lincoln twp. school, growing to adulthood on the family farm. At age 17 years, she accepted Christ into her life and remained true to her faith.

She lived all her life on the family farm. In 1978 she became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan and this had been her home since that time. She died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Wednesday, Nov. 24, 1982 at the age of 89 years, six months and 17 days.

In addition to her parents, Erick and Anna, she was preceded in death by two brothers — Enock and Willis Erickson and two sisters, Olina Gardner and Rebecca Johnson.
