Irene Forbes, 87

Minnie Irene Forbes, 87, of LeMars died Wednesday, Oct. 6, at Floyd Valley hospital after a long illness. She had been taken to the hospital Tuesday evening from Plymouth Manor.

Services were held at 1 p.m. Friday, Oct. 6, in the Mauer funeral home in LeMars with Rev. Leonard Root officiating. Burial was in the Kingsley cemetery.

Miss Forbes was born July 6, 1895 in Cherokee county, near Marcus to William and Emily Tanner Forbes. She was a bookkeeper at various places in Kingsley and was a buyer for Pelletier's department store in Sioux City for many years. She moved to Harlan where she operated a beauty shop for 20 years. In the early 1960s she moved to LeMars to make her home with her sister.
