

LIFE STORY OF —

PETER M. FREDERICK — 64

Peter Mathias Frederick was born March 27, 1896 at Portsmouth, to Peter L. and Mary (Kerth) Frederick and died at Veterans hospital, Omaha, Nebr., April 30, 1960 at the age of 64 years, 1 month and 4 days.

His life prior to serving with the United States Army during World War I was spent at Portsmouth, Iowa.

Since November of 1921 he had been with the United States Postal Service as rural letter carrier.

On October 11, 1921, he was married to Isabel Schaben at St. Peters Catholic Church in Defiance, and to this union seven children were born.

Survivors include his wife Isabel, one son Albert, Earling, four daughters, (Helen) Mrs Herman Albers, Omaha, (Marjorie) Mrs Tony Assman, Denver, Colo., (Elaine) Mrs Cleius Weis, Earling, and (Nona) Mrs John Kloewer, Omaha; 23 grandchildren; two brothers, John of Boone and Frank of Portsmouth; and two sisters (Ann) Mrs Bert Noll and Eva Frederick, both of Phoenix, Arizona. Two sons, William and Charles, preceded him in death.

A military funeral was held May 3, 1960 by the Earling American Legion with the Rt. Rev. Magr. Peter A. Bissen officiating at the 9 a.m. mass at St. Joseph's Church, Earling. Burial was in the church cemetery.
