

The Life Story of—

MRS WILSON B. FRIEND, 87

Dana Loretta Friend, daughter of Adolph and Maran Ebbesen Reyelt, was born July 4, 1887 in Shelby. She died at Myrtue Memorial hospital on July 10, 1974, just 6 days after her 87th birthday. When she was two years old she moved with her parents to Harlan and this has been her home since that time. On May 2, 1925 she married Wilson B. Friend in Des Moines. One son was born to this union. Mrs Friend has been a lifetime member of St. Paul's Episcopal church in Harlan. She was also a charter member of the American Auxiliary in Harlan and was one of the organizers for the Myrtue Hospital Auxiliary.

Mrs Friend was preceded in death by her husband, Wilson, on Oct. 3, 1954; by her parents; and two brothers - Alfred and Helmer Reyelt. She is survived by her son, James R. Friend of Boulder, Colo. a step daughter - Sarah (Mrs Dan Schamp) of Fulton, N.Y. two grandchildren - Bruce and Kathe Friend; and three step grandchildren - Stephen, Chris and Rick Schamp; by her two sisters - Miss Olga Reyelt and Mrs Norma Ruby, both of Harlan; by her niece, Mrs Bruce Ouren, of Harlan and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Saturday, July 13, 1974 at St. Paul's Episcopal church in Harlan with Rev. Glenn E. Rankin officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Bruce W. Ouren, H. W. Ouren, Jr., Donald Mathiasen, Harold E. Boysen, William O. Lewis, and Raymond L. Tredway serving as pallbearers.
