

# Alyce Giltner, 66

**IRWIN** — Mary Alyce, daughter of Charles and Grace Weatherall Bennett, was born Dec. 31, 1910 at Ute. She graduated from the Ute high school and married Everett George Giltner. They farmed in the Batavia community where her husband died April 15, 1962. Alyce continued to live near Batavia with her son, Norton until moving to Irwin, in 1971. She died at Jennie Edmundson hospital in Co. Bluffs, Monday, July 25, 1977 following a short illness at age of 66 years, 6 months and 24 days. Alyce was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary, Chapter 182 order of Eastern Star, the Church of Christ and Ladies Aid of the Church, all of Irwin.

Beside her husband, she was preceded in death by her parents, and by one brother, C. T. Bennett. Survivors include two sons, Dean and Norton of Batavia and one daughter, Mildred (Mrs Gary) Vannoy of Co. Bluffs, six grandchildren, Joyce, Mike and Jay Giltner, Deborah, David and Darren Vannoy and a sister, Mrs Margaret Redenbaugh of Sedalia, Colo.
