

GOESER, Sr. Cyprian

Sr. Cyprian Goeser, 86

Earling — Sister Cyprian was born March 25, 1894, near Earling, daughter of Joseph and Emelia Hunstock Goeser. She entered St. Rose Convent, Aug. 26, 1913. Sr. Cyprian, who had served the catholic church and community for 55 years as a homemaker and for some years as a teacher in the elementary schools of Iowa and Wisc., including St. Peter and Paul in Carroll 1948-1953; St. Francis, Maple River, 1966-1977; and Annunciation, Coon Rapids, 1968-1970. She died in Villa, St. Joseph on Thursday, April 24, 1980 at age 86 years.

She was preceded in death by two sisters - Sister Cyprian F.S. P.A and Sister Arilda, F.S.P.A. Survivors include a brother - Cyprian of Co. Bluffs; six sisters, Sister Mary Amelia (Wunibald) F.S.P.A.; and Sister Martha, F.S.P.A., both of LaCrosse, Wisc., Mrs Dora Muenchrath of Earling; Mrs Alfred (Romana) Schwery and Mrs William (Frances) Hahn of Harlan; and Mrs Ivan (Scholastica) O'Connell of Laramie, Wyo.

A Mass of the Resurrection was celebrated Monday, April 28, 1980, at St. Rose Convent chapel with Rev. Richard Wisnewski, officiating.
