The Life Story of --

STELLA GREGORY, 83

Stella Wokersien Gregory was born March 2, 1893 at Avoca. She moved with her parents to a farm close to Harlan and after her father's death in 1903 they moved to town where she attended the Harlan schools. She graduated from high school in 1911 and taught in country schools for several years in Wyoming. In 1919 she moved to Omaha with her mother and worked in the bond dept of the U. S. National Bank for 30 years. She married Roy Gregory in 1950 and when they retired moved to Minnesota, where they lived in the summers and spent the winters in Arizona. In 1968 they moved to their present home in Youngtown. She died March 15, 1976 at her home in Youngtown, after a long illness, at age 83 years.

Survivors include her husband, Roy; her twin sister - Agnes of Overland Park, Kans., a sister-in-law - Margritha Wokersien and two nephews - Tom Wokersien of Fairfield, Idaho and Kent Wokersien of Twin Falls, Idaho.

Funeral services were held at St. Joachims Catholic church, Sun City, Ariz., March 18, 1976 with burial in Sunland Memorial Park, Sun City.
