

THE LIFE STORY OF—
Charlotte Greve

ELK HORN — Charlotte Mae Greve, daughter of Daniel and Goldie Montgomery Jones, was born June 6, 1924 in Council Bluffs. On Dec. 25, 1942 she married Harold Greve in Omaha, Nebr. Charlotte was owner and operator of the Danish Pastry Bakery. She was a member of the Elk Horn Lutheran church and of the A.L.C.W. She died at her home in Elk Horn on October 21, 1976 at age 52 years, 3 months and 27 days.

She was preceded in death by her husband, 1969, her parents, a sister - Mrs Alvin (Margarete) Larsen and a brother - Robert.
