Manilla - Allen David Hall, son of Rollin and Emma Beaumont Hall, was born Jan. 28, 1917, south of Corning. He graduated from Corning high school in 1934 and worked on the family farm. He married Leota Drorbaugh on June 1, 1941 at her home near Lenox. They farmed ten miles south of Lenox for about four years, after that they moved to their present farm home north of Manilla in 1946. He died at University hospital in Omaha Monday, May 12, 1980, at age 63 years, 3 months and 14 days.

He was a member of the United Methodist church, Manilla, an active member of the Farm Bureau, which he served many offices. He also was a member of the Manilla school board for seven years.

He was preceded in death by his parents and by one brother, Raymond Hall. Survivors include, his wife, Leota, a one son, Gary of Harlan, a one daughter, Anita Lee (Mrs. Thomas) Benda of Beaumont, Texas, eight grandchildren, and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Thursday, May 15, 1980 at the United Methodist church in Manilla with Rev. Donald Jones, officiating. Burial was in the Nishnabotna cemetery with Virgil Bueltel, Bob Bohnker, Dick McCullough, Hal Cadwell, Dale McCone and Gilbert Bandow. Honorary casketbearers were
