Henry O. Hansen, 83 of Walnut, Iowa passed away Monday, Oct. 11, 1982 at the Cass County Memorial Hospital in Atlantic, Iowa following a long illness.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Oct. 13, 1982 at 2:00 p.m. at the Peace United Church of Christ in Walnut with the Rev. Bruno Romanowski officiating. Burial was in the Walnut Cemetery at Walnut.
