

The Life Story of --
JOHN HANSEN, 64

John, son of Nick and Anna Ronfeldt Hansen, was born March 12, 1908 near Irwin, Iowa. He attended the rural schools near his home. He farmed with his parents until the deaths of his father in 1934, and his mother in 1957. About a year after the death of his mother, John moved to Denver, Colo. where he worked as a carpenter. About 7 years later he began work for Petersen Turkey Farms near Denver, and continued to work there until failing health forced him to curtail his activities, earlier this year. He died at his home in Denver, early Wednesday morning June 21, 1972 at the age of 64 years, three months and nine days.

Other than his parents, he was preceded in death by three brothers and two sisters.

He is survived by the following brothers and sisters: Henry Hansen of Irwin; Mrs Mabel Nordby of Harlan; Louie Hansen of Manilla; Alice, Mrs Albert Albertsen of Council Bluffs and Alma, Mrs Frank Perry of Manilla and by eight nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were Saturday, June 24, 1972, at United Methodist Church in Irwin, Iowa with Rev George McMullen, officiating.

Burial was at Oak Hill cemetery in Irwin, Iowa. Serving as casket-bearers were: Merrill Callender, Mayor Knudson, Myron Kington, Roy Olson, Virgil Crouch and Lester Hass. The Ohde Funeral Home of Manning and Manilla was in charge of arrangements.
