Kimballton — Marie Hansen was born March 11, 1887 in Sharon twp., Audubon county, daughter of Peter H. and Mathilda Ingerslev. She was baptized and confirmed in the Bethany Lutheran church near Kimballton and has been a member of the Elk Horn Lutheran church since 1943.

On March 11, 1908 she married Peter V. Hansen. This union was blessed with four children. The family farmed in Audubon and Shelby counties. In 1943 they retired and came to Elk Horn. Peter died in 1948. Marie lived in her own home in Elk Horn until a year ago, when she moved to the Salem Nursing Home. She was a member of the Danish Ladies Aid, both in the Bethany Lutheran church and the Elk Horn Lutheran church. Marie died at age 92 years on Friday, Feb. 15, 1980 at the Salem Nursing Home, Elk Horn.

She was preceded in death by her parents; one sister - Mrs Ida (Andrew) Miller and one brother - Otto Ingerslev and one grandchild - Jean Bruch. Survivors include one daughter - Thelma (Mrs Theodore) Lange; three sons - Ralph and Herbert, both of Elk Horn and Ranald of Audubon, 12 grandchildren; 26 great grandchildren and two great great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Monday, Feb. 18, 1980 at the Elk

Horn Lutheran church with
Pastor Harry Thomsen, of-
ficiating. Burial was in the
Bethany Lutheran cemetery in
Kimballton with Gordon Lange,
Marvin Lange, Pete Hansen,
Richard Hansen, Robert Doonan
and James Farley serving as
