Kimballton — Hilda K. Hemmingsen, was born July 21, 1904 in Oakfield twp., Audubon county, daughter of Andrew P. and Marie Christensen Andersen. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran church. She attended rural school.

On March 7, 1934, she married Raymond Hemmingsen in the Elk Horn Lutheran church. Four children were born to this union. They farmed near Elk Horn for 43 years. In Sept. of 1977 they moved to Elk Horn. For the past nine years, Hilda has been restricted in her activities. She was interested in high school sports, while her boys were in school. She died at the Salem Lutheran Home in Elk Horn, Monday, July 16, 1979 at age 75 years. Survivors include: her husband, Raymond of Elk Horn; four sons: Reynor of Atlantic; Vernon of San Diego, Calif; Franklin of Elk Horn, and Dewey of Cedar Rapids; one sister - Bertha Andersen of Elk Horn; and eight grandchildren. Preceding her in death were her parents.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, July 18, 1979, at the Elk Horn Lutheran church, with Pastor Eugene Soland, officiating. Burial was in the Elk Horn Lutheran cemetery, with Hans Andersen, Vernon Knudsen, Emmert Steen, Raymond Hansen, Sidney Christensen and Clifford Nelson serving as casketbearers.
