

Estella Hess, 89

Washington — Estella Hess, daughter of Frank and Bertha Fairenbach Pierce, was born on April 8, 1891, near Story county.

On Sept. 16, 1908, she married Clyde Hardenbrook. One son, Donald was born to this union. Clyde died in 1920, at age 34. After his death, Estella was employed in various positions, eventually moving to Harlan.

On Oct. 8, 1932, she married Henry Hess in Harlan. After Mr Hess died on June 30, 1956, she continued to live in Harlan until 1977, when she moved to Seattle, Wash., to be near her grandson, Earl D. Hardenbrook and his family. Mrs Hess was a member of the Eastern Star for 58 years, receiving her 50 year pin from the Mapleton Eastern Star Chapter.

She died at Evergreen Vista Nursing Home in Kirkland, Wash., on Friday, Dec. 5, 1980, at age 89 years, 7 months and 27 days.

Survivors include her son, Donald Hardenbrook of Sioux City; three grandchildren; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Greenland Funeral Home, Alderwood Manor, Wash., on Tuesday, Dec. 9, 1980 at 2 p.m. with Pastor Vern Tooley, officiating. Burial was in Harlan cemetery on Thursday, Dec. 11, 1980 with Dr. Larry LaVelle of the First United Methodist church of Harlan, officiating. Graveside services were conducted by the Eastern Star, Lebanon Chapter No. 8, O.E.S. of Harlan.
