Portsmouth —Robert "Bud" Francis Huebner, son of John August and Lena Plambeck Huebner was born Jan. 3, 1915 on a farm three miles west of Portsmouth. He was baptized, received his First Communion and confirmation at St. Mary's Catholic church and attended St. Mary's Catholic school, both in Portsmouth. After graduating from the eighth grade, he grew to adulthood helping on the family farm.

On June 24, 1937, he married Catherine Ohlinger at St. Mary's Catholic church in Panama. Seven children were born to this union. After their marriage, they made their home on a farm near Panama for one year and then moved to a farm one mile south of Portsmouth, where they lived for 13 years. In 1951, they moved to their present farm, four miles southwest of Portsmouth. After retiring in 1973, they continued to live on the same farm.

He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church in Portsmouth. He died while enroute to the hospital on Wednesday, May 12, 1982, at the age of 67 years.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a grandson, John R. Turner and one brother, William Huebner. He is survived by his wife, Catherine of Portsmouth; three sons, Marvin of Persia, Merle of Portsmouth and Wayne of Neola; four daughters, Clarice (Mrs Marvin) Lengemann of Omaha, LaVonne (Mrs Francis) Turner of Co. Bluffs, Karen (Mrs Joel) Carlson of LaVista, Neb. and Roberta (Mrs

Michael) Peth of Co. Bluffs; 17 grandchildren; two brothers, John, Jr. of Omaha, and Harold of Portsmouth; five sisters, Clementine (Mrs Matt) Willems of Anton, Elma (Mrs John) Wright of Omaha, Pauline (Mrs Lawrence) Ohlinger of Harlan, Helen (Mrs Vic) Leinen of Des Moines and Marian (Mrs Herb Pedersen) of Hardy, Neb.; nieces, nephews and other relatives and a great many friends.
