# Father John J. Hyland

**MANILLA** — Father John J. Hyland was born in Waterford, Ireland on Feb. 7, 1908, son of James and Margaret B. McEvoy Hyland. He attended the National Elementary school in Ireland and the Patrician College (high school) in Mountrath, Ireland, Mungret College in Limerick and St. Patricks Seminary in Tipperary. He was ordained on June 7, 1931 in the Diocese of Sioux City at St. Kiernans College, Iklenny, Ireland. He was assigned as assistant pastor to St. Michaels parish in Whittemore. Father Hyland served the diocese for 42 years. Because of failing health he returned to Ireland in Sept. 1973. He also served as pastor to Sacred Heart parish in Manilla. St. Patricks in Sheldon, St. Michaels in Whittemore and St. Marys in Dow City and Buck Grove. He died on Saturday, Sept. 25, 1976.

He is survived by two brothers, Father William P. Hyland of Jemez Springs, N. M., and Father Francis Hyland of Yorkshire, England, two sisters, Mrs A. N. (May) Birkett of Nottingham, England, and Mrs Francis (Sheila) O'Donnell of Tipperary, Ireland.

Funeral services were held Sept. 28, 1976 in Lisbronagh Co. Tipperary, Ireland. Burial was also in Ireland.
