Emma S. Jacobs, 83

Emma Sophia Jacobs, the daughter of James and Paulina Lagoni Johnson, was born Oct. 23, 1899 on a farm near Harlan. She attended country school near Harlan, through the 8th grade. After school she helped on the family farm while growing to adulthood.

In 1919 Emma married Roy Reinhart in Harlan. Two children were born to this union. After married they lived and farmed south of Harlan. In 1954 Emma went to work at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan, where she worked as a Nurses Aid.

On Dec. 11, 1962 Emma married Wallace Jacobs at Muskogee, Okla. After marriage they made their home in Harlan. Mr Jacobs died on July 11, 1963. Emma then continued to live and work in Harlan. In 1971 she retired and then made her home with her sister Bertha Hansen in Harlan.

Mrs Jacobs died on Feb. 24, 1983 at her home in Harlan having attained the age of 83 years, 4 months and one day.

In addition to her parents and husbands, Emma was preceded in death by one baby daughter; and two brothers, Charles and Herman.

She is survived by her son Eldon Reinhart and wife Alma of Carroll; four sisters, Cecelia Goodman of Woodbine, Mathilda (Mrs Frank) Reinhart of Carroll, Bertha Hansen of Harlan and Edith Ames of Denison; one granddaughter and two great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews, other relatives and many friends.
