

Arthur Jacobsen, 85

Arthur Dewey Jacobsen, son of Mary M. Jensen and Clarence P. Jacobsen was born May 8, 1898 at Kimballton. He attended Audubon co. and Polk twp. rural schools. During World War I he served in the U.S. Army.

On June 29, 19822 he married Sarah Hansen in Elk Horn. During his life he worked for the Manning Creamery, was a mechanic, sold cars and was in the produce business. In the late 1930's he moved to Mill Valley, Calif., where he operated Jake's Taxi Service until his retirement to Harlan in 1959.

He was a member of the First Baptist church; where he also served as church custodian for many years. He has been a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan since this past fall. He died at Myrtue Memorial hospital on Monday, March 5, 1984 at the age of 85 years, 9 months and 27 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; five brothers, Norman, Arnold, Leonard, Leslie and Ethan and two sisters, Olga Knudsen and HESSIE Jacobsen. Survivors include his wife, Sarah of Harlan; one brother, Howard Jacobsen of Dana Point, Calif.; two sisters, Clara, Mrs Merle Weimer of Big Bear Lake, Calif. and Leanna, Mrs Einjer Jensen of Harlan. He is also survived by many nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, March 7, 1984 at the Burmeister Funeral Home with Rev. John M. Leggett, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Floyd Jensen, James Jensen, Bill Jacobsen, Wilmer Knudsen, Harold Shaffer, Marvin Knudsen and Jack Knudsen serving as casketbearers.
