CHRISTIE JENSEN, 69

Christie Larsen Jensen, daughter of Christina Jensen and Martin Nielsen, was born Jan. 16, 1906 at Hjorring, Denmark. She died June 16, 1975 at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at age 69 years and 5 months. She married Hans Larsen, Dec. 30, 1931 in Omaha, Nebr. After their marriage they farmed in the Kimballton area until 1936 when they moved to Jefferson. In 1948, they returned to the Kimballton area and later retired to Harlan. In 1974, she married Julius Jensen at Elk Point, So. Dak., they have made their home at 905 Court St. in Harlan.

Mrs Jensen was preceded in death by her parents, her first husband, Hans, and a sister, Lillian Nielsen. Survivors include her husband Julius, one brother, Otto Nielsen of Glenwood, three sisters, Miss Anna Nielsen of Omaha, Nebr., Mrs Esther Hansen of Harlan and Gladys Larsen (Mrs Lawrence) of Coon Rapids; five step-sons, Gerald, of Sioux City, Daryl of Harlan, Virgil of Loveland, Colo., Larry of Maryville, Ohio, and Donald of Rochester, N.Y.; two step-daughters, Marilyn (Mrs Fred Stamp) of Harlan and Karen (Mrs Leon Brockolesby) of White Pine, Mich.; 16 step-grandchildren and nieces and nephews.
