# Elmer K. Jensen, 67

Harlan — Elmer Kal Jensen, son of Ed and Mary Jensen was born Nov. 28, 1913 on his parent's farm near Irwin, where he also grew to adulthood.

After their marriage, they lived on a farm near Irwin while Elmer bought and sold cattle and also worked at the sale barns.
