



## Robert L. Jensen, 47

Jacksonville — Robert Lyde Jensen, son of E.L.P. (Pete) and Evelyn Petersen Jensen, was born on a farm in Clay twp Shelby county on Oct. 15, 1930. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. He attended country school through the 8 grade and then completed his freshman year at Elk Horn. Robert then attended the Harlan high school and after graduating in 1948, was engaged in farming.

In Dec. of 1950, he entered the Air Force and served during the Korean conflict. After receiving his discharge in Dec. of 1954, he returned to the Jacksonville area and farmed. On April 17, 1954, he married Susan Long in Blair, Nebr. Two sons were born to this union.

After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Jensen made their home on a farm near Jacksonville. This has been his home since that time. Mr Jensen died Tuesday, Sept. 12, 1978, as the result of a tractor pick-up accident just north of Atlantic. He would have been 48 years old this coming Oct. He was a life time member of the Bethlehem Lutheran church in Jacksonville.

His survivors include his wife, Susan, of Harlan; two sons - Michael Jensen of Creston and Randy Jensen, at home; his parents, Mr and Mrs E. L. P. (Pete) Jensen of Harlan and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at the Bethlehem Lutheran church in Jacksonville, on Friday, Sept. 15, 1978, with Pastor Howard Wolfgram, officiating. Burial was in the Jacksonville cemetery with Verdell Hess, Ralph Doonan, Roland Hansen, Keith Andersen, Emmert Knudsen and Merle H. Petersen serving as casket-bearers.
