

# Mrs Johanne Johansen

AUDUBON — Mrs Johanne Johansen was born Jan. 3, 1890 in a log cabin in Luck, Wisc., daughter of Fritz and Margaret Skow Hansen. She was baptized in the North Luck Lutheran church in 1890 and confirmed there on Mar. 5, 1904. On Mar. 7, 1913 she married Rasmus Johansen in Luck, Wisc. Seven children were born to this union. The family moved to Elk Horn in 1918 where they farmed. After 18 years they moved northeast of Kimballton and continued to farm. They retired in Audubon in 1947 and lived there until Mr Johansen's death in 1969. Johanne was a resident of the Friendship Home the last two years. She died Sunday, Febr. 20, 1977 at the Audubon hospital.

She was preceded in death by her husband and two sisters. Survivors include her children - Everett Johansen of Audubon, Waldo Johansen and Mrs Folmer (Elsie) Juel of Harlan, Mrs Max (Mildred) Warren of Audubon, Mrs Forrest (Dorothy) Petersen of Harlan, LeRoy Johansen and Robert Johansen of Chariton, 21 grandchildren and 13 great grandchildren.
