IRWIN — Dale Allen Jorgensen, son of James Christian and Martha E. Johnson Jorgensen, was born in Harlan on Febr. 16, 1903. He died at the Lutheran Medical Center in Omaha, Nebr., on May 2, 1977, at age 74 years, two months and 16 days. He attended grade school in Harlan until 1913 when he moved with his family to Irwin. He completed his schooling in Irwin and after graduating, farmed near Irwin with his brother until 1947. At that time he moved to Omaha, Nebr. In partnership with his brothers, he managed a cattle feeding operation in Omaha and Irwin. After retiring in 1966, he continued to make his home in Omaha and this has been his home since that time.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by three brothers - Leonard, Dewey and Paul Jorgensen. He is survived by two sisters - Marie Jessen of Van Nuys, Calif., and Helen Gloeckl of Sarasota, Fla.; three brothers - Norman and Clarence Jorgensen, both of Omaha, Nebr., and Elliott Jorgensen of Harlan, nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at the Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan on Thursday, May 5, 1977, with Pastor Emil C. Martinson, pastor of the St. Paul's Lutheran Church of Irwin, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery, with Bill Brue, LaVern Brue, Lyle Knudsen, Lester Larson, Robert Larson and Carl Armentrout serving as casket-bearers.
