

John C. Juhl, 82

Irwin — John Christian Juhl, son of Louis and Mary Sorensen Juhl, was born on a farm in Center Twp. He attended a country school, and at the age of 12, he moved with his parents to a farm near Irwin.

On March 27, 1922, he married Lille Paulsen in Atlantic. Five children were born to this union. They farmed all of their married life in the Irwin vicinity. Following Mrs Juhl's death in 1973, Mr Juhl continued to make his home in Irwin. Mr Juhl was a long time member of the Seventh Day Adventist church in Audubon. Mr Juhl died at the Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan, on Wednesday, June 18, 1980, at age 82 years, 6 months, and 29 days.

In addition to his parents and his wife, he was preceded in death by one son, Wayne; infant twins, a brother and a sister; two other brothers, Harry and Alfred; and one other sister, Clara. Survivors include two sons - LaVern of Irwin and Virgil of Manilla; two daughters - Dorothy (Mrs Junior) Holloway of Defiance and Marcia (Mrs Robert) Holloway of Defiance; 16 grandchildren; and ten great-grandchildren; by a sister, Anna (Mrs Soren) Sorensen of Audubon; three brothers - Walter of Irwin, Clarence of Irwin, and Lester of Bellevue and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan, on Friday, June 20, 1980, with Pastor Leo Campbell, pastor of the Seventh Day Adventist church in Harlan, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery, Harlan, with Merle Juhl, Randy Juhl, Lowell Juhl, John Holloway, Jerry Holloway and Kevin Holloway serving as casketbearers.
