

**Mrs Ernest A Kardell, 69**

Lucille Kardell, daughter of William E. and Elsinia Michaelson Roberts, was born March 19, 1915 in Redline. She died at the home of her daughter in Kimballton on Oct. 5, 1974 at age 59 years, 6 months and 16 days. She attended Polk Township School and Harlan high school and grew to adulthood in Redline community. She married Ernest A. Kardell on Oct. 7, 1931 in Omaha, Nebr. Four children were born to this union. After their marriage, the Kardells lived in Redline until 1934 when they moved to a farm near Avoca. They later moved to a farm near Audubon, where they farmed until 1967. They then came to Harlan and this has been her home since that time. Mrs Kardell has been a member of Immanuel Lutheran church in Harlan since moving to this community.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Ernest, just six weeks ago on Aug. 21, 1974, by her oldest son, Billy, in 1970 by a granddaughter, Debbie Kardell in 1953, by her parents and one brother — George W. Roberts.

She is survived by her three children - Marilyn (Mrs Marvin Mikkelsen) of Kimballton, Ben of Spencer and Marlene (Mrs Merlin Buthmann) of Harlan, by fourteen grandchildren, her sister — Jessie (Mrs John Vithen) of Harlan and her brother, Glenn Roberts of Iowa City.
