AVOCA — Arthur Hansen Kasner, 88, died Monday at the Harlan hospital after a long illness.

He was a lifelong resident of the Avoca community. Kasner graduated in 1910 from the Avoca High School in 1914, from Coe College at Cedar Rapids and did post graduate work in business management at Northwestern University at Evanston, Ill.
