

Stella E. Klindt, 83

Stella Edith Klindt, daughter of John Franklin and Mary Louise Howlett Lee was born March 24, 1898 in Fairview twp., Shelby co. She graduated from the eighth grade at the Fairview No. 6 county school and then took two more years of advanced schooling there. She grew to adulthood helping on the family farm.

On Dec. 7, 1919, she married Carl Peter Klindt at her parents' home in Fairview twp. Six children were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed for seven years in Monroe twp. in Shelby co. and then in Fairview twp. for many years. After Mr Klindt died on Jan. 27, 1968, she continued to make her home on their farm.

She was baptized at the Altamont Baptist church in Shelby co, in July of 1934 and has been a member since that time. She was also a member of the Altamont Baptist church Women's Circle and a charter member of the Sunshine Seekers. She died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Saturday, Dec. 26, 1981 at the age of 83 years.

In addition to her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by one grandson, Carl Lee Klindt and one great grandson, Christopher Klindt; one brother, Lloyd Lee and one adopted sister, Lela Irene Christensen.

Survivors include five sons, Lee, Max and Ralph, all of Avoca; David of Harlan and James of Atlantic; one daughter, Muriel (Mrs William) McIntosh of Honey Creek; 24 grandchildren and 19 great grandchildren; nieces, and nehews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan on Tuesday, Dec. 29, 1981 with Pastor Roger Porter of the Altamont Baptist church officiating.

Burial was in Cuppy's Grove cemetery in Shelby co. with Timothy Klindt, Bruce McIntosh, Duane Piittmann, Shelia K. Klindt, Dallas D. Klindt, and Lee W. Klindt, Jr. serving as casketbearers.
