

Paul Kloewer, 75

MANILLA — Paul, son of Anton and Barbara Gaul Kloewer, was born June 4, 1903, at Westphalia. He attended the Westphalia school. Later his family moved to Defiance. On Sept. 2, 1930 he married Josephine Roecker. They farmed near Manilla and later Paul worked as a trucker and auto mechanic.

After four weeks of hospitalization, he passed away at the Crawford County Memorial Hospital in Denison on Tuesday, Oct. 17, 1978, at the age of 75 years, four months and 13 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, three brothers and one sister.

He is survived by his wife, Josephine, one son, Delmar, of Edina, Minn.; one daughter, Theresa, Mrs Roger Lapel of Bloomington, Minn. and by five grandchildren. He is also survived by four brothers and one sister, Pete, Joe and Marie of Defiance, Herman of Keosauqua, and Vincent of Manilla.
