FORMER RESIDENT DIES

David Kolb, former Elk Horn area farmer, died Feb. 7 at Clarkson hospital in Omaha.

He was born June 19, 1919, the son of Walter and Carrie Clark Kolb, both of whom preceded him in death.

He is survived by his wife, Thelma of Omaha, his son Paul and wife Jan of Blair, Neb. and a sister, Elinore Alexander of Davenport, Ia.

He served in the Air Corps in WW1. He came back and farmed on the home place until 1952. He served for several years on the Shelby County draft board. He moved to Oakland and worked for Northern Natural Gas Company and was later transferred to their Omaha office until he retired July 1, 1981.
