HENRY KOOS, 84

WALNUT — Henry W. Koos was born Dec. 8, 1890 in Pottawattamie county, son of Jurgen and Margaret Wamser Koos. He died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Oct. 10, 1975 at age 84, following an extended illness. He married Anna Sornsen Dec. 11, 1912 at her parents home in Shelby county. He farmed, sold insurance and for many years was clerk of Layton township. He was a member of Peace United Church of Christ and was a 50 year member of the Masonic Lodge.

Surviving are his wife, Anna; two sons, Ervin of Shelby and Norman of Omaha; a daughter, Mrs Don (Geneva) Drustrup of Mo. Valley; a sister, Mrs Harold (Emma) Lafrentz of Walnut; six grandchildren and 20 great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, three brothers and four sisters.

Funeral service was held on Monday, Oct. 13, 1975, at Peace United Church of Christ in Walnut, with Pastor Harold Petersen of Trinity Lutheran church of Avoca officiating. Burial was in the Walnut Cemetery with Charles Koos, Robert Koos, Larry Crispin, David Koos, Larry Kock and Robert Lafrentz serving as casketbearers.
