

Missouri Valley bank president John Kovar dies

MISSOURI VALLEY — John A. Kovar, president of Peoples State Bank in Missouri Valley, died Feb. 9 at an Omaha hospital. He was stricken with an apparent heart attack at the bank earlier that day while attending a meeting.

Kovar, 87, was also president of Kovar Insurance Company in Missouri Valley. He was a Missouri Valley resident since 1921, and was active in establishing the Missouri Valley Country Club, Community Memorial Hospital and the airport.

Surviving are a son, Paul, an associate of Peoples Bank; a stepbrother, Vaclav Kovar and stepsister, Anna Vessla, both of Howell, Nebr.; four grandchildren and a great-grandchild.

Services were held Feb. 12 at St. Patrick's Church in Missouri Valley.
