MRS LOREN KROLL, 41

Marjorie Ann Kroll, daughter of Arnold and Edna Sumner of Samuelson was born April 16, 1934, on a farm near Dow City and died Tuesday, Jan. 6, 1976 at Clarkson hospital in Omaha, Nebr., after a brief illness at age 41 years, 8 months and 20 days. Mrs Kroll attended school in the Dow City area. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. On Dec. 27, 1951 she married Loren Kroll of Dunlap. They settled on a farm west of Dunlap. After several years they moved to Harlan where they lived for twelve years before moving to Dow City last year.
