

**THE LIFE STORY OF —
CHRISTINA KROMAN, 91**

Christina Marie Kroman, daughter of Albert and Marie Christensen was born June 29, 1884 on a farm near Jacksonville. She died May 20, 1976 at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn at age 91 years, 10 months and 21 days. She was baptised and confirmed at the Jacksonville Lutheran church and attended school at Jackson No. 9. On April 21, 1910 she married Andrew H. Kroman at Elk Horn and to this union six sons were born. After their marriage they farmed the same farm for over 65 years. She moved to the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in January of this year and spent the remaining months of her life.

In addition to her husband - Andrew, Mrs Kroman was preceded in death by her parents, three sons - Albert, Donald and an infant son, one brother - Chris and two sisters - Mrs Thomas Christensen and Miss Katherine Christensen. Survivors include three sons - Peter and wife Arlene, Howard, and Robert of Elk Horn, a daughter-in-law, Mrs Norma Jean Kroman of Kimballton, one sister - Bertha (Mrs Chris Eskov) of Elk Horn, six grandchildren, two great grandchildren, many nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held at Elk Horn Lutheran church in Elk Horn Saturday, May 22, 1976 with Pastor Eugene Soland, officiating. Christensen serving as casket-bearers with burial in the Elk Horn cemetery.
