Peggy Kuehl, 41

Margaret E. (Peggy) Kuehl was born July 5, 1941 to Emil Will and Bernyce Constable. As a young girl she attended the public schools at Irwin and graduated from high school there. She then attended business college at Omaha. Following her schooling she moved to Worthington, Minn., where she was employed at a local bank.

She married Darrel Kuehl, March 1, 1969 in the Church of Christ at Worthington, two daughters were born to this union. The family lived on a farm in Rosehill twp of Cottonwood co. She was active in the Rosehill Extension club and loved raising flowers, her garden and sewing. She was a vacation bible school helper in her church.

She died of cancer on Wednesday, April 6, 1983 at Worthington Regional hospital at the age of 41 years, 9 months and 1 day.
