WALNUT — John Kutnink, 74, longtime Walnut area farmer, died Sunday night (Nov. 23) at Myrtue Memorial Hospital, Harlan. He apparently suffered a heart attack at his home and was taken to the hospital by the Walnut Rescue Unit.

Services were held Wednesday afternoon at the Berthusen-Knutson Funeral Home here, with burial in the Walnut Cemetery.
