

Clarence O. Lacey, 75

Harlan — Clarence Odell Lacey, son of William Albert and Mary (Thraen) Lacey, was born July 17, 1905, in Harlan, where he also grew to adulthood.

On July 21, 1926, he married Gladys Ivadell Carlson in Audubon. One son, Clarence John, was born to this union. They made their home in the Harlan area for most of their married lives where Mr Lacey was employed for many years at the Gamble Store and then as an electrician at various locations including several foreign countries. He died at Myrtue Memorial hospital on Sunday, Jan. 25, 1981, at age 75 years, 6 months and 8 days.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by three step brothers and one step sister. Survivors include his wife, Gladys of Harlan and his son, John of Ames, three grandchildren, Kevin of Corvallis, Oreg., Cynthia of Iowa City, and Valerie of Ames; one sister, Marie Rose of Denver, Colo.; and other relatives.
