DOW CITY — Matthew Lahr, three-year-old son of Dale Lahr of Dow City, was killed Tuesday afternoon (Sept. 22) in Dunlap when he was struck by a pickup truck.

Harrison County Sheriff Merle Sass said Randall Dumond of Soldier was driving down an alley behind the Dunlap Post Office when the child ran into his path from

behind some bushes. The boy was dead at the scene.

Sass said Lahr had been staying with a baby-sitter at the time of the accident.

## injured in Dunlap alley

WOODBINE — Matthew Lahr of Dow City, age 3, was fatally injured in an accident in an alley in Dunlap Tuesday, Sept. 22.

According to Deputy Sheriff Denny Hansen, who investigated, Randall Leroy Dumond of Soldier was driving a 1973 Chevrolet truck through the alley when the small child ran in front of his vehicle. Matthew was the son of Mr and Mrs Dale Lahr. He was taken to the Community Memorial Hospital in Missouri Valley by the Dunlap rescue unit.
