

Theodore B. Lange, 80

Elk Horn — Theodore Bernhard Lange, son of Christian and Sarah Petersen Lange, was born April 14, 1899 in Clay twp, Shelby county. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran church.

He married Thelma Hansen in Elk Horn on Feb. 18, 1932. They farmed for seven years in Shelby county and for 25 years in Audubon county. They lived in Elk Horn for the past 14 years. He died Thursday, Nov. 22, 1979 at Myrtue Memorial hospital at age 80 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents and five brothers—Andrew, Arnie, Max, Marinus and Elmer. Survivors include his wife; two sons - Marvin and Gordon, both of Audubon; two sisters - Christina (Mrs Edwin) Hansen of Elk Horn and Helga Wheatley of Quasqueton and five grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Nov. 24, 1979 at the Elk Horn Lutheran church with Pastor Eugene Soland, officiating. Burial was in the Elk Horn cemetery with Russell, Mark and Jack Lange and Galen, Richard and Peter Hansen serving as casketbearers.
