PAPILLION, NEBR. — Karen K. Langenfeld of Council Bluffs, stepmother of four Harlan residents, died last weekend from injuries received when she was struck by a pickup truck.

Law enforcement authorities said Mrs. Langenfeld, 37, was walking along U. S. Highway 275-Iowa 92 near the Interstate 29 interchange about 1:30 a.m. Saturday when she was struck by a truck driven by Joseph Duysen, 26, Omaha. A police report indicated Mrs. Langenfeld was walking on the roadway in the right, westbound lane. Duysen also was westbound in the right lane.

She is survived by her husband, Robert; a daughter, Christina of Council Bluffs; and four stepdaughters — Patty Jacobsen, Debbie, Diane and Dixie Langenfeld, all of Harlan. The latter three reside with their mother, Kay Hansen, at 2110 Seventh St., Harlan.

She is also survived by her parents, the Roy Stickneys of

Tecumseh, Nebr., and three sisters and two brothers. Services were held Tuesday afternoon in Papillion, Nebr.,

where the Langenfelds had once resided.
