

Ewald Lansman

OMAHA, NEBR. — Ewald Tenus Lansman, son of Chris and Julia Hansen Lansman, was born on a farm in Shelby county, on June 5, 1904. He died at Eppley Care Center in Omaha, Nebr., on Mar. 8, 1977, at age of 72 years, 9 months and three days. He attended country school in Polk twp and grew to adulthood on his parent's farm. On Sept. 22, 1934, he married Margaret Bristol at Rockport, Mo. Five children were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Lansman made their home in the Persia, Denison & Harlan vicinities. Mr Lansman worked for John Deere for a while and also sold feed. Later he was a produce buyer in and around southwest Iowa. He retired in 1952 and moved to Omaha and this has been his home since that time. Mr Lansman was a long time member of the Baptist church.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by three brothers - Chris, Ray and Charles; and by a sister, Sophie. His survivors include his wife, Margaret, of Harlan; four sons - Roger and Rodney, both of Omaha, Gale of Edmond, Okla., and Gary of Little Rock, Ark., a daughter, Linda (Mrs Richard Berry) of Harlan and by 12 grandchildren, three sisters - Minnie Christensen and Clara Nielsen, both of Omaha and Nina Sorensen of Atlantic; two brothers - Harry Lansman of Pomona, Calif. and Emanuel Lansman of Harlan; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan on Thursday, Mar. 10, 1977, with John Kinyon of the Harlan Church of Christ officiating. Burial was in the Merrill's Grove cemetery, Shelby county with Mr Lansman's nephews James Brace, David Lansman, Harold Lansman, Merlin Sorensen, Robert E. Lansman and Verdon N. Sorensen serving as casketbearers.
