

Agnes M. Larsen, 86

Elk Horn — Agnes Marie Larsen, daughter of Nels C. and Catherine Andersen, was born Jan. 30, 1891 in Atlantic. She moved to Peoria, Ill., with her parents where she worked with her father as a tailor. She returned to this area when she was 20. She married Andrew Larsen on March 3, 1923 in Elk Horn. They farmed Andrew's home place until 1943, when they moved to Elk Horn and lived for 20 years. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran church. She moved to St. Louis to live with her sister after Andrew's death. In 1965 she became a resident of the Salem Home in Elk Horn, this is where she died Dec. 21, 1977 at age 86 years, 11 months and 9 days.

Survivors include one brother, three sisters and nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held Monday, Dec. 26, 1977 at Hansen Memorial Chapel in the Salem Retirement Home with Pastor J. H. Thomson, officiating. Burial was in the Elk Horn cemetery with James Fink Jr., Wilbert Vollmer, Howard and Lester Esbeck, Fred and Alvin Larsen serving as casketbearers.
