Alvin F. Larsen, 71

Alvin F. Larsen was born April 24, 1911 in Audubon co. He was one of three children born to Hans P. and Christina Hyrup Larsen. He was baptized and confirmed in the Elk Horn Lutheran church, Elk Horn, where he was currently a member.

He married Margarette Jones, April 1, 1942 in the Savior's Lutheran church in Omaha, Neb. He has farmed in Audubon co., all his life and lived in the same area all his life. Margarette died Jan. 9, 1962. Alvin continued to live on the farm. During World War II he served in the U.S. Army.

He died at his home east of Elk Horn on Sunday, Dec. 12, 1982. Survivors are one son and daughter-in-law: Gary and Donna Larsen of R.R. Exira; one daughter and son-in-law: Linda and Larry Reep of Harlan and five grandchildren.

Preceding him in death were his parents; his wife; one sister: Ruby (Mrs Melvin) Bladt; and one brother: Ernest Larsen.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Dec. 15, 1982 in the Elk Horn Lutheran church in Elk Horn. Officiating Pastor was Rev. Eugene Soland. Burial was in the Elk Horn cemetery. American Legion Services were held at the graveside.
