GUDRUN LARSEN, 81

Elk Horn — Gudrun Larsen, daughter of Laura and Hans Marquesen was born on May 2, 1894 in Sharon twp. in Audubon. She was one of 11 children. She worked in her father's store in Elk Horn until she married. She was baptised and confirmed in the Lutheran church and joined the Adventist church after marriage. She married Harry Larsen in 1912 and two children were born to this union. They farmed south of Elk Horn, but later moved to Elk Horn where Harry worked for the town and the Elk Horn Lumber Co. Harry died in 1961 and Gudrun moved to the Salem Nursing Home, where she died June 10, 1975 at age 81 years, 1 month and 8 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents, four brothers and one sister and a daughter - Gladys (Mrs LeRoy) Larsen. Survivors include her son - Hans of San Diego, Calif., 11 grandchildren, several great grandchildren, six sisters - Mertie Hennick of Exira, Olga Olson, Seattle, Wash., Hansie Andersen of Omaha, Nebr., Frances Larsen of Ottumwa and Kathryn Hans and Gladys Lensch, both of Exira and Storm Marquesen of Ft. Dodge.

Funeral services were held on June 13, 1975 at the Hansen Memorial Chapel, Salem Retirement Home in Elk Horn with Pastors Roger Cain and J. H. Thomsen, officiating. Burial was in the Elk Horn cemetery.
