MISS METHA K. LARSEN, 77

Metha Kirstine Larsen, daughter of Ane Katrine Andersen and Lars Larsen was born April 15, 1897 on a farm in Sharon township, near Elk Horn, Ia. She died Nov. 15, 1974 at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at age 77 years and 7 months. Miss Larsen was educated in rural Audubon county schools and attended the Elk Horn College. She has been a

telephone operator and spent many years of her life helping the Elk Horn Community as a practical nurse, working in both the Salem Retirement Home as well as in the Nursing Home. She was a baptized and confirmed member of the Elk Horn Lutheran church.
