Kenneth Robert Lebeck, the son of Andrew and Grace Burger Lebeck, was born at Carroll, on Dec. 12, 1926 and died in a drowning accident near Audubon, on July 21, 1983 at the age of 56 years, 7 months and 9 days.

He attended Viola and Auduon Public Schools. He married Eva Boye and they raised their family in Audubon. He was a member of the Audubon Volunteer Fire Department for 25 years. He loved trapping, hunting, and antique collecting and was a fur buyer for many years. He also worked for Audubon County Road Maintenance, was a truck driver, back hoe operator, scrap metal dealer and worked on pipe line construction for Northern Natural Gas.
