## Stella M. Lewis, 96

Stella Mabel Lewis, daughter of Eugene J. and Mary Frances Clark Smith was born Oct. 20, 1885 in Harlan. She attended school, graduating from Harlan high school and then went on to graduate from the University of Iowa.

On Feb. 10, 1916, she married Anson Lewis in Harlan. After their marriage, they made their home in Harlan, where she taught the third grade. During their married lives, they traveled extensively and lived in Canada, Okla. and S.D., before moving back to Harlan. After Mr Lewis died on June 18, 1955, she continued to make her home in Harlan. For the past three years, she has made her home at the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan during the winter months and then returning to her home during the summer.

Mrs Lewis was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal church in Harlan, the St. Katherine's Guild of St. Paul's Episcopal church and the P.E.O. club of Harlan. She died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Wednesday, June 30, 1982, at the age of 96 years.

She was preceded in death by her husband and parents. She is survived by her nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at St. Paul's Episcopal church in Harlan on Saturday, July 3, 1982 with Fr. Glenn Rankin officiating.

Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Gene Reisz, Keith More, Jerry Lapke, Don E. Blakely, Vic Christensen and Dean L. Frederickson serving as casketbearers.
