

# Thomas K. Lloyd, 85

Spencer - Thomas King Lloyd, son of William and Eliza Davis Lloyd, was born Dec. 14, 1894 in Linn Grove. He received his education in Linn Grove and later graduated from Roosevelt high school in East Chicago, Ind. After graduation, he attended Morningside College in Sioux City for two years. In June of 1918 he entered the Marine Corps serving in WWI. He completed his military service on Aug. 13, 1919 and went back to Morningside College where he later graduated.

After college, he coached in Harlan and was there for ten years. After his coaching, he opened a hardware store and operated it for seven years. Following that, he worked at the Veteran's Administration in Des Moines until entering the army and serving WWII. After the war, he made his home with Gwen Lundt at Marathon and in 1947, they moved to Spencer and lived there since. He lived at St. Luke's Lutheran Home for two years. He died Monday, March 31, 1980 at St. Luke's Home in Spencer at age 85 years, 3 months and 17 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, five sisters and two brothers, by six nephews, a niece and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, April 2, 1980 at Spencer with Rev. Rob Cumings, officiating. Burial was in Barnes Twp. cemetery in Linn Grove with Wilmer Lundt, Ralph Lundt, Jack Cleveland, Joe Breidinger, Bob Brostad and Leonard Anderson serving as casketbearers. Honorary bearers were Herbert Farnes, Carl Ness, Dr. L.W. Larson and Benny Johnson.
