

Ethyl L. Loutzenhiser, 93

Ethyl Leta Loutzenhiser, daughter of Daniel and Nellie Tague Terrill was born Oct. 1, 1888 in Douglas twp., Shelby, co. She attended school in both Center and Harlan, growing to adulthood in Douglas.

On Oct. 30, 1909, she married Harry Loutzenhiser at the United Methodist church in Kirkman. After their marriage, they made their home in Blockton, Des Moines, Kirkman and Omaha, Neb. After Mr Loutzenhiser's death in June of 1958, she continued to make her home in Omaha until moving to Harlan in 1968. She made her home at the Colonial Manor Nursing Hoem in Avoca, for four years and in Nov. of 1980, she became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan. This has been her home since that time.

She was a member of the United Methodist church in Kirkman. She died at the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan on Saturday, Dec. 26, 1981 at the age of 93 years.

She is survived by her two nieces, Mrs Don Frederickson and Mrs Gene Barkman, both of Harlan; her brother-in-law, R.D. Loutzenhiser of Villisca and her sister-in-law, Miss Minnie Loutzenhiser of Kalamazoo, Mich.; and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan on Tuesday, Dec. 29, 1981 with Pastor David E. Cave, of the Congregational United Church of Christ officiating.
