JOSEPH MARKS, 73

Joseph Marks, son of Frank and Louise Faria Marks, was born in San Leandro, Calif., on Oct. 12, 1900. He died at his home in Harlan on Aug. 21, 1974, at age 73 years, 10 months and nine days. He married Victoria Hansen on Sept. 30, 1941 in Reno, Nev. After their marriage Mr and Mrs Marks lived in Oakland, Calif. For over 20 years he was with the Hunter's Point Naval Shipyards. They moved to Harlan in 1967 and this has been their home since that time.

Joseph was preceded in death by his parents and one brother - Alvin. He is survived by his wife - Victoria of Harlan; one daughter - Shirley Marks living in Calif.; two sisters - Elsie (Mrs Frank Faria) and Mrs May Martin, both of San Leandro, California; one brother - Frank of San Francisco, Calif.; nieces and nephews and other relatives.
