WILLIAM A. MEADERS, 75

EARLING — William Anton Meaders, known to all as Wally Meaders, was born Oct. 5, 1898 in Audubon. He was the son of John and Rose Mary Jacobs Meaders. He died at Myrtue Memorial hospital on Mar. 8, 1974 at age 75 years, 5 months, 3 days. He lived with his parents and family in Dunlap for a short time before moving to Earling when he was 5 years old in 1903. This has been his home since that time. He was confirmed at St. Joseph's church in Earling and he has been a member of this church most of his life. He has also been a member of the Earling Council No. 1741 Knights of Columbus for many years.

Wally was preceded in death by his parents; his brother - John H. Meaders and his infant sister - Rosalie Meaders. He is survived by his 15 cousins and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated at St. Joseph's church in Earling on Monday, Mar. 11, 1974 with Very Rev Msgr. Michael W. Schwarte as celebrant.
